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1.2 Startup relaxation is not given for this tender.

2. Financial Criteria:-

- 2.1 The bidder's average annual financial turnover during the last 3 years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year shall be Rs **165.61 Lakhs** or higher.
- 2.2 The bidder's net worth should be positive as per the latest audited balance sheet.

3. Variable Pricing:-
