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1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or their reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Documentary evidence of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the last 1 year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.

3. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) of 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be a manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. The Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If the bidder is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM_No.1_4_2021_PPD_dated_18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application.

Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India 2017). Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

5. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 20% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of multiple bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

6. Short Duration Bid has been published by the Buyer with the approval of the Competent authority due to Emergent procurement of critical products/services.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25% of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the order quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The purchaser and the bidder are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Scope of Supply

3. Turnover

Bidder Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3 years old, the average turnover in respect of completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

4. Certificates

ISO 9001: The bidder or the OEM of the offered products must have ISO 9001 certification.

5. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Note:

- (i) Bidder should have ISO certificate in the concern items.
- (ii) Bidder should have MSME certificate in the concern items.
- (iii) Bidder has to bring samples of preferred brands as per list of approved make only and Engineer in Charge shall approve one sample out of the samples before opening the technical evaluation by the bidder. The bidder is to use material of that approved sample only. The decision of Engineer-in-Charge in this regard is final and binding.
- (iv) Bidder Should upload Affidavit for acceptance of conditions of the bid document on 100 Rs stamp paper.
- (v) Bidder should upload Non-blacklist certificate on 100 Rs stamp Paper.
- (vi) Bidder should upload ATC Acceptance Certificate on 100 Rs stamp paper.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority, Government Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these clauses and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.

3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category i bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which share with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
