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- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
- 5. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. - 6. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
- 7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
- 8. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 50% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.
- 9. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

- **(a) Bidder Financial Standing: -** The Bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or simila r proceeding, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.
- (b) Data sheet of the product(s) offered in the bid are to be uploaded alongwith the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the data with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.
- (c) While generating invoice in GeM Portal the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the scre enshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST. Supply shall ensure that the invoice is raised in the name of consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.
- (d) All Boats should be registered by Inland Water Transport (IWT) West Bengal and should have the valid fitness certificate for one year w.e.f. April' 2024 to March' 2025.
- (e) Maximum parameters such as Aadhar Number, GST Registration, should be included in bid document s /tender.
- **(f) CERTIFICATE:-** If any doubt on the seller submitted relevant documents i.e. turnover, experience, sup ply orders and other bid documents are liable to be verified by the BOOs or competent authority. If found i ncorrect /fake, the bidder shall be blacklisted for 02 year.
- **(g) CERTIFICATE: -**Bidder will upload a self-certificate stating that the firm has not been blacklisted by an y Govt/PSU agencies in recent past.
- **(h) CERTIFICATE:** -Bidder has to submit an undertaking that their firm has never submitted any fake/forg ed/edited misleading documents in any of the government department in the last 02 years, and their documents have never been found -fake/ forged/edited/ misleading by any government department in the last 02 years. If the undertaking is found false/manipulative/misleading, the firm shall be blacklisted for 02 years from BSF.
- (i) **CERTIFICATE:** Bidder has to give an undertaking on letter head that their firm has not defaulted in th e supply of any contract issued by any Government Department in last 2 years in a consignee. If the under taking found false/manipulative/misleading, the firm shall be blacklisted for 02 year from BSF.
- (j) **CERTIFICATE:** All participated firms should submit complete Udhyam registration certificate with all annexure.

- **(k) RIGHT TO REJECTION :-**Stores will be accepted after inspection and only if they are found up to the s tandard specification. The decision of the BSF shall be final as to the quantity of the stores and shall be bin ding upon the tenders and in case of any of the articles supplied not being found as per losses caused to s upplies should be borne by the supplier and ensured by the supplier that articles supplied should be best in quality and free from all defects. The rejected stores must be removed by the tenderer from the consignee's premises within 15 days from the date of intimation about rejection at the risk and cost of the tenderer. The in charge stores concerned will take reasonable view of such materials but in no case shall be responsible for any loss shortage damage that may occur to it while is in the premises of the consignee.
- (I) Liquidated Damages:-In case the firm does not complete the supply within the laid down agreed delivery period as per contract, action will be taken against the firm as per Clause 9.7.9, 9.7.10 & 9.7.11 of Manual for procurement goods 2017, MOF.
- (m) ARBITRATION:- The latest General Terms and Conditions on GeM 4.0 (version 1.7) clause No. 16.2 (a rbitration) is as under,

In the event of any conflict/dispute arising out of or in connection with this contract placed through GeM, w hich has not been resolved in accordance with the procedure laid down in Clause 16.1 above, the aggrieve d Party may invoke Arbitration by sending a written notice to the other party. The procedure for appointme nt of the Arbitral Tribunal shall be as follow.

In cases where the total value of the contract is less than INR 1,00,00,000/- (Indian Rupees one Crore only) the same shall be referred to a sole arbitrator mutually appointed by both the parties.

Where the total value of the Contract exceeds INR 1,00,00,000/- (Indian Rupees one Crore only) the arbitration shall be conducted by a quorum of three arbitraors. Each party shall be entitled to appoint an arbitrat or and the two party appointed arbitrators shall within 30 (thirty) days from their nomination, appoint a thir d arbitrator i.e. the Presiding Arbitrator.

In case of failure to appoint the President Arbitrator within period of 30 (thirty) days from their nomination of the two arbitrators by the respective parties, the aggrieved party shall app roach the High Court (under shoes jurisdiction the principle place of business of the Buyer department/organization is located) to appoint the President Arbitrator as per the provision of the Arbitrator and Conciliation Act 1996 (as amend ed up to date).

The arbitrator shall be conducted in the English language. Arbitration proceedings can also be conducted o nline, as per the discretion of the Arbitral Tribunal.

The cost of the Arbitration shall be equally borne by both the Parties.

The award of the Arbitration shall be final and binding on the Parties to the Contract. The arbitration shall be governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, as amended up to date. The seat of arbitration shall be at the place where the principle place of business of the Buyer department/organization is located.

The Contract shall be interpreted and governed in all respects in accordance with the laws of India. All disp utes in connection with or arising out of the Contract, shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Co urt within the local limits of whose jurisdiction principle place of business of the Buyer department/organiz ation is located.

(n) FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE:-If at any time, during the continuance of this contract, the performance i n whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by re ason of any war, hostility, acts of public enemy, epidemics, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts or act of God provided notice of the happening of such event duly evidence with documents is given by one party to the other within 10 days from the date of occ urrence thereof, neither part y shall be by reasons of such event, be entitled to terminate the contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or del ay in performance, and deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such ev ent has come to an end or ceased to exist, and the decision of the Buyer as to whether the deliveries have been so resumed or not, shall be final and conclusive, Provided further that if the performance in whole or part or any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 10 days, either party may at its option terminate the contract provided also that the Buyer shall be at liberty to take over from the seller at a price to be fixed by Buyer, which shall be final, all unused, un damaged and accepted materials, brought out components and Goods in course of manufacture in the pos session of the seller at the time of such termination or such portion thereof as the Buyer may deem fit exc epting such materials, bought out components and services as the Seller may with the concurrence of the Buyer elect to retain.

(o) WARRANTY:-Timely servicing/rectification of defects during warranty/contract period, after having be en notified of the defects/service requirement during warranty period, Seller has to complete the required Service/Rectification with 15 days' time limit. If the seller falls to complete service/rectification with define d time limit, a penalty of 0.5% of Unit price of the product shall charge as penalty for each week of delay fr om the seller. Seller can deposit the penalty with the buyers directly else the Buyer shall have a right to re cover all such penalty amount from the Performance Security (PBG), Cumulative penalty cannot exceed m ore than 10% of the total contract value after which the buyer have the right to get the service/ rectification from alternate sources at the risk and cost of the Seller besides forfeiture of PBG. Seller shall be liable to reimburse the cost of such service/rectification to the Buyer.
