1. Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is

made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. 3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Detailed Terms and conditions -1. Officer-in-charge:

Dy.Manager / Manager /SM (CMM) shall be officer-in-charge for this contract.

Dy.Manager/ Manager /SM (CMM) (Materials) CMM, KGS 1-4, Plant Site NPCIL Kaiga Generating station Dist-Uttar Kannada 581400 Intimation regarding drawl of supply on as and when basis will be given by Officer-In-Charge or his authori sed official.

2. Loading and unloading:

a. Loading and Handling at supplier's work/premises shall be 'supplier's scope' at no extra cost.

b. Unloading and Handling at Kaiga Generating Station site shall be NPCIL's scope.

c. Necessary accessories and fittings to be made available by the seller for supplies in tankers so that the s ame can be matched with available fittings at NPCIL Kaiga.

3. All the necessary precautions to ensure the Safe delivery of material at Plant site shall be taken conside ring the category of material. Any Environmental hazard in transit shall be the responsibility of the seller.

4. Each consignment should accompany with material Test Certificate.

5. All rates and quantity are on 100% concentration basis. The quoted rates shall be for 100% purity and p ayment of the supplied material shall be released as per the actual percentage of purity of caustic soda Ly e-rayon grade received based on NPCIL Lab test report.

6. Material is to be supplied in staggered manner on as and when required basis within 10 days of issue of intimation from Officer In Charge or his authorised officials.

7. Delivery completion Date :

One year from the date of contract or till the completion of supply of ordered quantity whichever is earlier. However if required the delivery completion date can be extended based on mutual consent.

8. Quantity variation

(a)One years consumption of KGS would be tentative as mentioned in indent for supply . However it may p lease be noted that no guarantee can be given for procurement up to the ceiling limit indicated above, as t he requirements will be drawn on 'as and when required basis up to the delivery completion date.

(b)Quantity mentioned in the indent is Tentative quantity and shall be required on as and when required b asis if needed, hence no guarantee can be given for consumption of all the quantity mentioned above.

10. The chemical should be a product of Chlor-alkali process and shall not be through any Organic process /industry like, chloroparaffin industries / plasticizers / dye industries etc. The bidder shall submit document ary evidence regarding the manufacturing process of NaOH.

11. The quality of Chemical shall be in accordance with the IS-252:2013.

12. The supplier shall submit the Certificate of Analysis (CoA) / Test report for each of supply and the same shall contain results of all the parameters as given in the IS -252. In case of non submission of CoA / Test re port at the time of supply, the consignment will be rejected.

13.
