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1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Bidder must have manufactured/supplied at least one similar Package AC unit of Minimum 5.5 TR Capacity during the last seven years ending last day of previous month in which NIT is issued i.e. 31.12.2024. Copy of executed one PO to be submitted along with your offer.

**B.** Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

**C.** Provisions of revised "Public Procurement" (Preference to make in India) order 2017 notified vide order no. P- 45021/2/2017-PP (BE-II) dated 19/07/2024 of Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) shall be applicable.

Bidders seeking benefits under Purchase Preference to Make in India (linked with local content) shall have to comply with the provisions specified under the revised Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) order 2017. The salient features of which are as under:
